Silicon Valley kept wide VC lead as deals, funds grew in 2013

Venture deals done and dollars invested in California rose in 2013, according to a new report that shows the state continues to hold a wide lead over the rest of the nation on those fronts.

Venture database firm CB Insights reported that VCs did deals in 47 states last year, but the only one with double-digit numbers in deals and dollars was California.

The state, which is itself dominated by activity in Silicon Valley and the San Francisco Bay Area, had 1,449 deals with about \$14.8 billion invested.

AOL co-founder Steve Case, now a venture investor himself, has predicted that investing east of the Mississippi will soon eclipse Silicon Valley.

But it looks like the eastern half of the country has a lot of ground to make up to make Case's prediction come true. All of the states on that side of the divide totaled just over \$10 billion in VC deals last year.

New York had the second highest number of deals, with 396, and the third highest dollar total, with about \$2.9 billion.

Massachusetts was No. 2 in dollars, with \$3.04 billion invested, and No. 3 in deals, with 318.

California also led the nation in the number of venture-backed companies that went public or were acquired last year, although the total dropped about 4.5 percent to 229 exits. Massachusetts and New York showed similar declines.

A drop in mergers and acquisitions accounted for the drop in exits.
